Rules:

Enter the parade line by turning onto "Central Drive" located west off Division Street/Vassar Road at the Vassar Schools bus garage. Follow "Central Drive" past Central School turning left (south) onto N. West Street. You will receive your line-up number in the driveway through the Central School parking lot. **You will not be allowed to enter the parade route by any other street.**

Equestrian (horse) entries must provide a clean-up team.

There can be no throwing of candy or other items due to safety concerns, however candy and other items may be handed out by participants walking the route. Stay with your parade entry and be careful of the other entrants as you move about distributing items during the parade.

All entries must be "family friendly," no exceptions.

The Indemnification Agreement must be signed by a party legally authorized for each entry, no exceptions.

We reserve the right to refuse entry to our parade.

2017 RiverFest Parade

Theme: *Board Games*

Please note that while compliance with the theme is not mandatory, we do encourage it to enhance the enjoyment of participants and spectators.

Our parade begins at the corner of Athletic and Division Streets. It proceeds south on Division Street to Huron Avenue/M-15, turning east to North Cass Avenue, west onto East Oak Street, north onto North Main Street, west onto East Maple Street, north onto Division Street and finally west onto the Central School access drive at the bus garage.

Entrant “staging” for Police, Emergency Vehicles, Vassar High School Band, Mounted Police and Color Guard is in the parking lot across Division Street from VHS at the corner of Athletic and Division Streets.

During the parade, we ask each entrant maintain approximately 20 to 40 feet (roughly 1 – 2 car lengths) distance to the entrant in front of you. We need to maintain a responsible, safe distance without large spaces between entrants.

The City of Vassar, Vassar Chamber of Commerce and the RiverFest Committee thank you for your cooperation and participation. You help make RiverFest the success that it is.

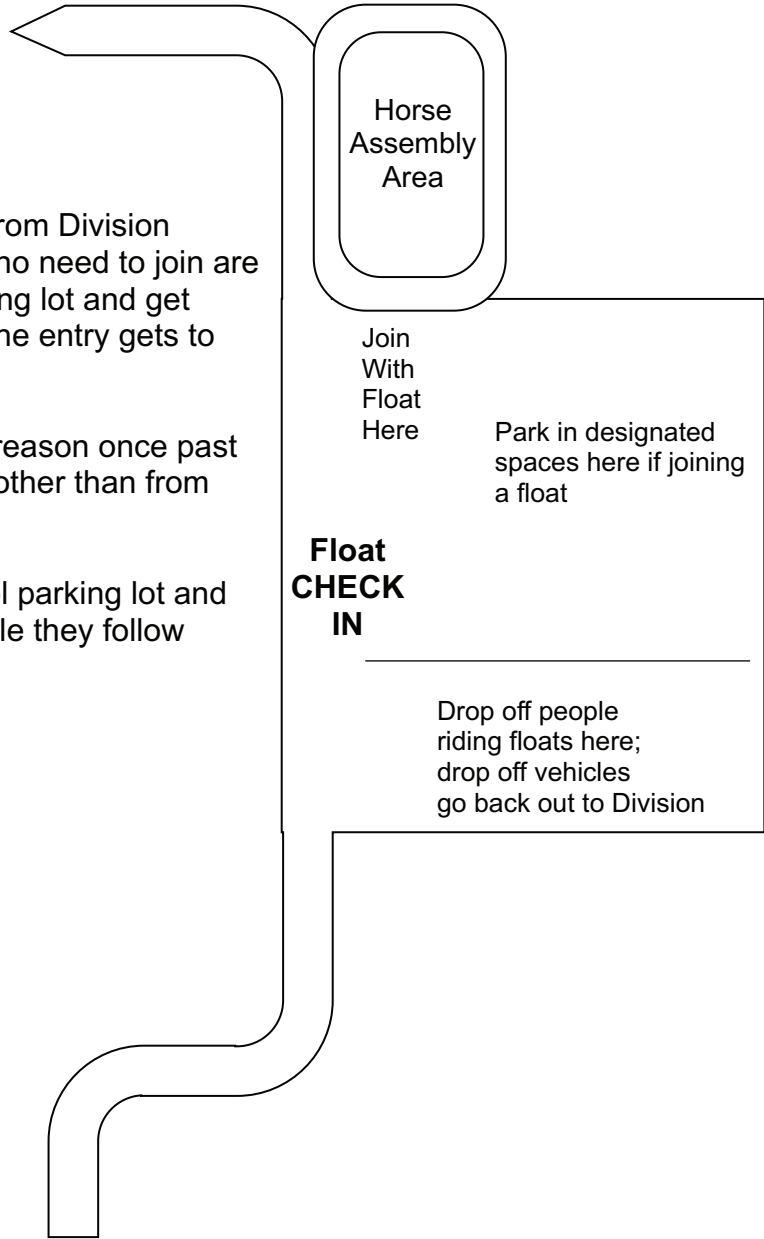
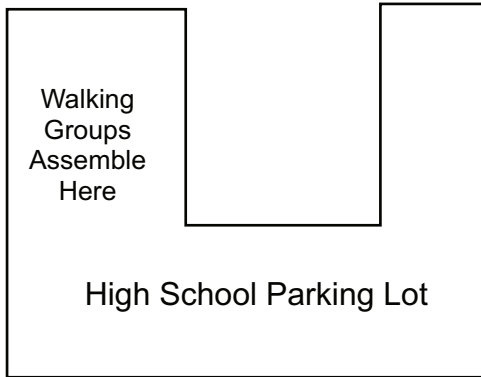
North West Street

All vehicle and float entries enter Central School Drive from Division Street. Any people not traveling with the float/vehicle who need to join are to be dropped of in the east end of Central School parking lot and get in/on the entry in the Central School parking lot before the entry gets to North West Street.

Do not proceed against the one way traffic flow for any reason once past the check in point. Do not enter the flow with a vehicle other than from Division Street into the Central School parking lot.

Groups walking the parade assemble in the High School parking lot and will be "slipped in" to the lineup order as the float / vehicle they follow turns from Athletic onto Division Street
